Unnamed 2021 Adaay x II Deserte

A colt half-brother to many winners. Havisham (by Mount Nelson) has won on the flat and over jumps, Ebony N Ivory (Equiano) has won on the flat and Adams Park (Mastercraftsman) is a winner over jumps. Perhaps the best of his half-brothers is St Barths (by Cadeaux Genereux) who was third in the Group 2 Coventry Stakes at Royal Ascot in 2011.



Unnamed 2021 Mahsoob x Bajan Rebel

Bay filly by Mahsoob, out of four times winner Bajan Rebel. She is fully registered for the Great British Bonus Scheme. The GBB is an industry-wide prize scheme for British bred fillies that allows the opportunity to win up to £20,000 per GBB eligible race.

Mahsoob was a smart middle-distance horse by Dansili bred by Shadwell and winner of the Earl of Sefton group 3 at Newmarket.

Bajan Rebel, was a winner of 4 races from a distance of 7 furlongs to a Mile. She is from a winning family. Her dam Silca Key was the winner of 3 races and a half-sister to 5 winners, from a family of Irish 1000s guineas winner Front Row.
